
Please note: The accuracy of your reports depends on how well you filter for your target population (e.g. your audience).


Log into your SGreports manager, and go to your respective Wowza profile. This will take you to your Overview section. *

Select Stream names from the left column.




In the Stream names window, select your stream name (i.e. streamName) by clicking the zoom icon.



In the Filters dialog box, click Move to Saved, then select the Saved tab.



In the Saved tab, click the Save and Apply button.



Now the top of all your reports will indicate that a stream name filter is in effect.
