## **Exporting SGreports**

Log into your SGreports manager, and select your respective profile.




In the left column, go to one of your report sections (e.g. Pages). \*


The Pages section; as well as all other exportable sections, will have an icon that looks like a dog-eared page on the top right of the report table. To export your report, click this icon.



In the Export Table dialog box, make sure All is selected, then click the Export button.



Right click the "Open or save CSV file" link, and select "Save Link As..." from the pop-up menu.



Name and designate the location of your file accordingly, then click Save.
