

SGreports WMS ATH (Aggregate Tuning Hours)

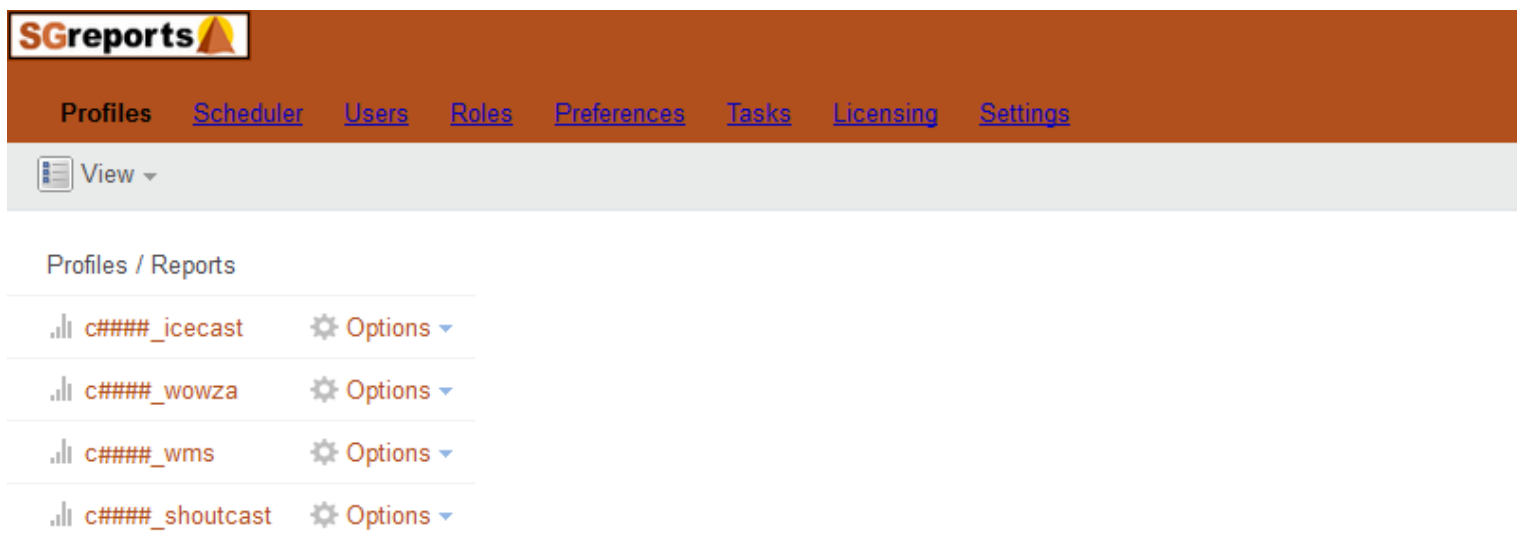

Log into your SGreports manager, and select your respective WMS profile.



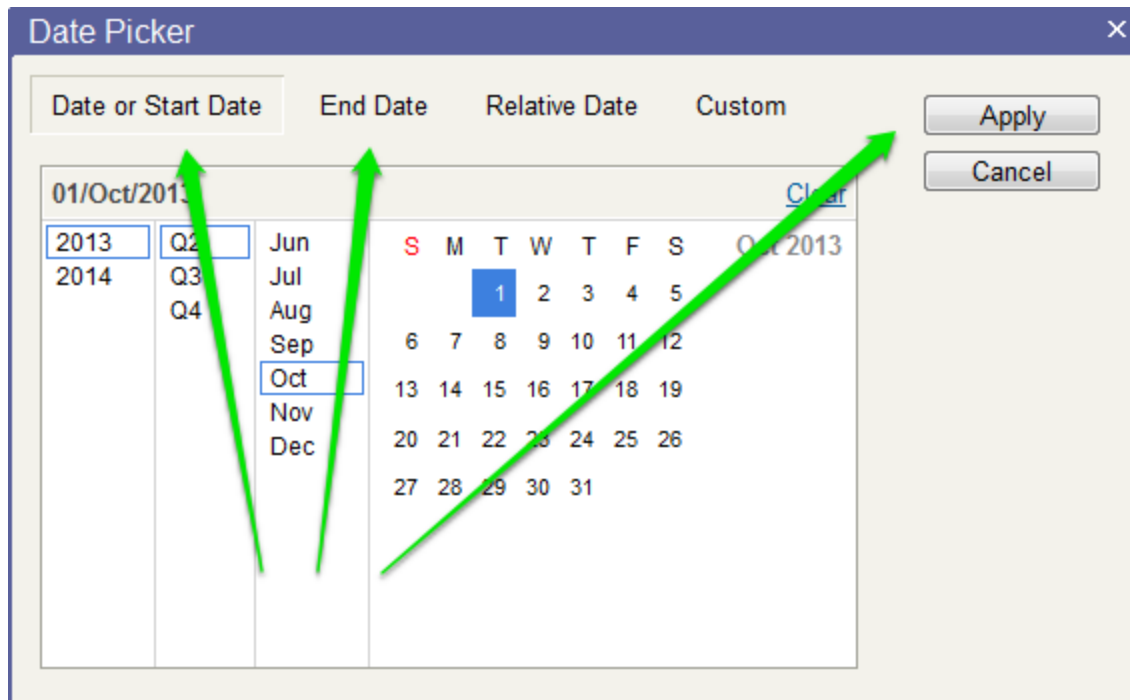
This will take you directly to the Overview section. Click the Date Picker on the top left to select the date-range for the ATH.



In the Date Picker dialog box, select the beginning and end date-range for the ATH.

1. Click on “Date or Start Date” and select the beginning date for the date-range. *
2. Click on “End Date” and select the last date for the date-range. *
3. Click the Apply button.

** Please note: Each field must have a value.*



You'll now see the Overview report for your selected date-range. The Play Duration is your ATH.
